We are looking for someone to...

- Direct our music as part of our church in Portsmouth.
- Work with choir (and group of musicians), including leading the choir.
- Take a lead of a group on the choice of music including hymns, songs, anthems and settings, guided by the service rota reflecting lectionary/festival themes. Choices should be made bearing in mind what will help encourage worship with the whole congregation.
- Play our recently refurbished tab stop, two manual pipe organ at all major services; at most Sunday services in the church e.g., three out of four
- Lead, prepare and encourage the choir in hymns, songs, anthems, and responses with a regular weekly practice.
- Introduce to the congregation new music when needed hymns, songs.
- Keep a record of music for overview and assist the person reporting for CCLI purposes.
- Work with choir members, the Rector, and Ministry Team to encourage children and young people.
- A possibility for you to use of organ for teaching.
