

Hi Everyone

As part of the precious ministry of Brian & Judith to The Kurdish Community in Portsmouth and beyond, please see attached a request for help.

Please continue to keep Brian, Judith and their work in your prayers. Judith writes the following about Brian's trip tomorrow to The Kurdish refugee camp at Dunkirk.

*"We gather that the refugees have now been moved into improved quarters nearby at La Liniere – which was built by Medecins Sans Frontiere - and that the camp enjoys much better organisation, with a new volunteer group called Utopia56 organising toilet and shower facilities, distribution of aid, meals etc. There are plans for a clinic, advice office and permanent school to be established which is where I think the Kurds of Portsmouth could help i.e. collecting supplies for the school etc.*

*Brian and Ahmed plan to leave Tuesday afternoon for Dunkirk, staying overnight and returning Wednesday evening. They will need much prayer to cover this trip as everything is in a bit of a state of flux and we are having trouble getting into contact with Utopia56 so may not be able to give them prior notice of our arrival and need for overnight accommodation etc!!"*
